

## CLASS NOTES

### STUDENTS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWING, UNDERSTANDING, AND ADHERING TO THE INFORMATION IN THESE NOTES

1. **BADM 468** is the Capstone course for the BBA-Bus Admin degree. Students in the class are required to take the Major Field Test (MFT) for Business. The MFT will be administered as an online exam during the course of the term, but outside of class hours. Taking the MFT is a graduation requirement.
2. **BIOL 111** meets 6:00 – 10:00 pm. Labs will be held in class.
3. **BIOL 201** meets 6:00 – 10:00 pm. Labs will be held in class. The prerequisite is BIOL 111.
4. **BIOL 220** meets 6:00 – 10:00 pm. Labs will be held in class. The prerequisite is BIOL 111.
5. **BIOL 223** meets 6:00 – 10:00 pm. Labs will be held in class. The prerequisite is BIOL 220
6. **BIOL 301** meets 6:00 – 10:00 pm. Labs will be held in class. The prerequisite is BIOL 334..
7. **BIOL 334** meets 6:00 – 10:00 pm. Labs will be held in class. The prerequisites are CHEM 111 & CHEM 113.
8. **BIOL 336** meets 6:00 – 10:00 pm. Labs will be held in class. The prerequisites are BIOL 111, BIOL 223, and CHEM 113.
9. **CHEM 111** meets 6:00 – 10:00 pm. Labs will be held in class.
10. **CHEM 113** meets 6:00 – 10:00 pm. Labs will be held in class. The prerequisite is CHEM 111.
11. **ENVS 111** is a Blended class and will meet every Friday 5:30-7:45 in class. Labs will be held on some Saturdays. Dates will be announced in class.
12. **ENVS 112** is a Blended class and will meet every Friday 5:30-7:45 in class. Labs will be held on some Saturdays. Dates will be announced in class.
13. **GEOL 111** labs will be held on some Saturdays. Dates will be announced in class.
14. **GEOL 112** labs will be held on some Saturdays. Dates will be announced in class. The prerequisite is GEOL 111.
15. **PSYC 330** is a semester-long, blended class that ends November 19. Students in PSYC 330, who have not taken PSYC 267, should also register for that course in Fall I term. The SPSS software program is used in both PSYC 267 and PSYC 330. That program is available on computers to students during the day at the Ft. Bragg office and the Pope computer lab. Limited access is also available during class periods in the evenings Mon-Thur. at either the Ft. Bragg computer lab in the Soldier Development Center or the Pope computer lab. Evening access is limited due to classes being held in the computer labs.

### COMPUTER ACCESS FOR STUDENTS

The Fort Bragg and Pope campuses each maintain computer labs or additional computer assets available to students on a limited basis. All computers maintain the normal software required for any courses offered.

**Fort Bragg Computer Lab**, located in Room 204 of the Soldier Development Center, is used primarily for classroom instruction Monday – Thursday evenings. Students may use it between classes or if permitted by the instructor holding a class. The lab is not available during the day or on weekends.

**Fort Bragg Office** has four computers available for use during normal office hours. Check in with the front desk at the office.

**Pope Computer Lab**, located adjacent to the Pope office, is used primarily for classroom instruction Monday – Thursday evenings. Students may use it between classes or if permitted by the instructor holding a class. The lab is also available for use during normal office hours. Check in with the front desk at the office. The lab is not available on weekends.
