We schedule proctor exams Monday through Thursday 9:00 am-1:00 pm, Closed Federal Holidays (Our scheduling hours are 8:30am-3:00pm).

**Appointments are only scheduled through our offices not through your home school.

- Before your scheduled exam, email Sarah Rosser at rossers@campbell.edu to verify your exam has been received. We do not contact your instructors for test.

On your test appointment, please arrive 15 minutes before your test to pay your proctoring fees. We only accept Visa and MasterCard; NO cash or check is accepted.

Please be aware that your instructor will provide us with a list of items you are allowed to use during your test. Before your test, you are instructed to leave all unauthorized items in a the storage bin we provide. Any items that are found in your testing area will be reported as items used on test (i.e. cell phones, notes, or textbooks) . Any incidents, we will be reported to your instructor and university for further actions.

FYI

Beginning on Oct. 1, 2011, Excelsior College Exams (ECE) will no longer be funded by DANTES. This goes for all Service members as well. Service members are encouraged to contact their local education officer to determine whether or not their respective service branch provides Tuition Assistance funding for exams or if they can access other military education benefits to pay for ECEs after Sept. 30, 2011.
